1. Scope: This addendum covers the WSCA Facilities MRO Contracts lead by the State of

- 2. <u>Participation:</u> Use of specific WSCA cooperative contracts by state agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state contracts are subject to the approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.
- 3. <u>Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Price Agreement:</u>
  The vendor will remit to the State of New Mexico Contract Manager an Administrative Fee in the amount of one percent (1%) of all total sales for New Mexico State and Local Public Bodies from this contract. Checks should be made payable to the State of New Mexico.
  - 1. The vendor must also agree to supply the State of New Mexico, State Purchasing Division, with a quarterly usage report broken out, at a minimum, to the state agency and local public body level.
  - 2. The periodic report shall include the gross total sales for the period subtotaled by procuring agency name. The report shall be accompanied with a check payable to State Purchasing Division for an amount equal to 1% of of the gross total sales for the period.
